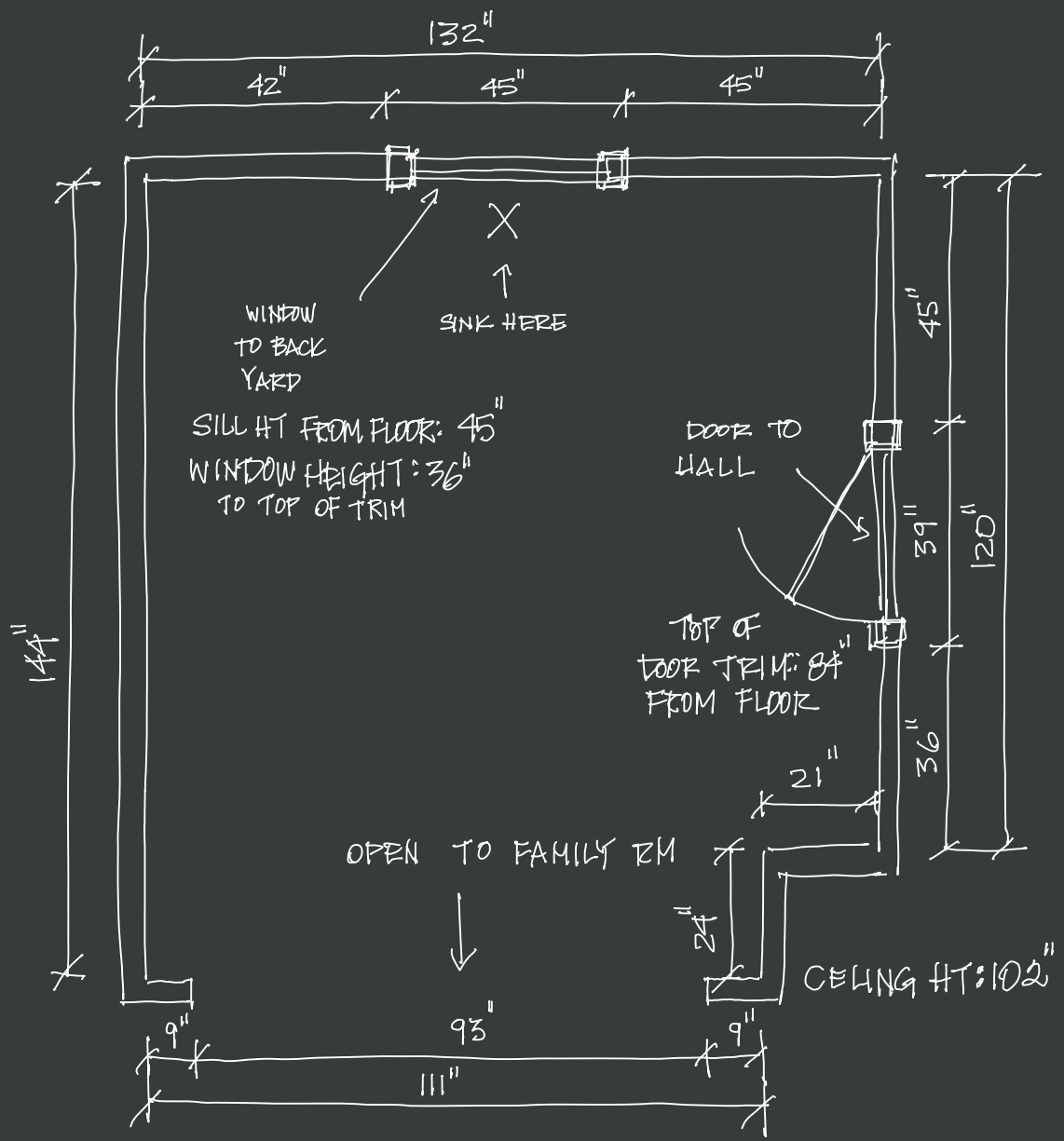


HOW TO MEASURE

- 1 - Gather three items: paper, metal measuring tape, and a pencil/pen.
- 2 - Draw the shape of the room's footprint to the best of your ability.
- 3 - Measure the ceiling height - write it on the side.
- 4 - Measure each of the room's walls, end to end, and write the measurement on the paper next to each of the walls.
- 5 - Draw on each wall where there is an opening (like a door or window).
- 6 - Measure each of those openings from the outside to the outside of the trim around it. Both height and width. If it's a window, measure from the floor to the top of the window sill.
- 7 - Write where each door opening is leading to and what the windows are looking out at as this will influence the design of your kitchen.
- 8 - Measure the wall space to the right and left of each of those openings. Write those measurements by the wall they refer to.
- 9 - Please note any mechanical locations that will not change, for example: the sink plumbing.
